

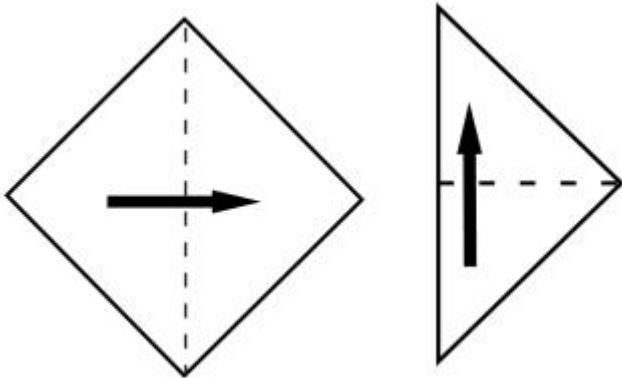
# Paper Snowflake



## You will need:

- 6 square pieces of paper, for instance 15x15 cm (6"x6"). Recycled paper is fine.
- Scissors
- Magic tape

Start by folding three A4 sheets of paper in two and cutting them into right size 15x15 cm.



Fold one of the square pieces of paper twice (see above) so that you get a triangular shape (see below). Make six cuts in the closed side of the triangle (see below).

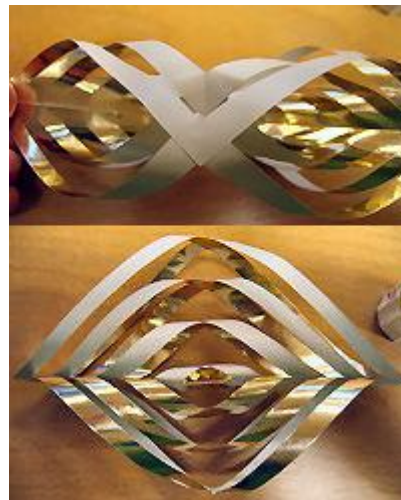


Open the cut triangle and tape the corners of the middlemost strips together with a small piece of magic tape. Turn the whole sheet around (face down) and

tape the next strips. Turn and tape until all the strips have been taped.



Below: A finished point as seen from above and from the side.



Fold, cut and tape the other five square pieces of paper in a similar way.



Tape one end and the middle of the points together into groups of three with a folded piece of magic tape. (Folding makes the tape double-sided).

Tape the two groups together and hang.
