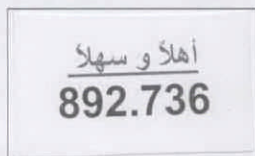

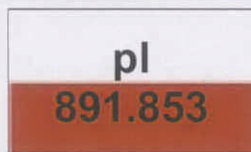
Looking for something to read that's not in English? We've 19 languages in our new selection of World Languages books. They can be borrowed just like any other item in the Library or Learning Centre.



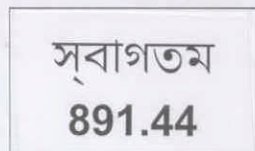
Many of the books are novels or stories. Some are original modern writing in a language, others are translations from English. The young people's picture books include some with an English text as well - look for the Dual Language label. For several languages we also have books or CDs to help speakers of that language improve their English.



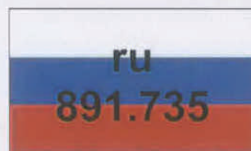
Where are they? Adults books are in the Learning Centre, children's books in the Library.



Where is the language I want? Find books in your language by looking for the Dewey number on the spine. Books will also carry a flag or label, which will be unique for that language. Look around this poster. Dual language books carry a Dual Language label.



Looking in the library catalogue? To see all our books in any particular language, look at our online catalogue - in the Library, Learning Centre or on the web at www.shetland-library.gov.uk



Choose Library Catalogue, then select the Search tab at the top.



In the Keyword box, enter the Dewey number for the language you want.



In the Collection menu choose either Adult non-fiction for adults books or Junior Non-fiction for children's books. Please remember that we have a much greater choice of languages in Children's books.



Press the Search button to see the list.
